BACKGROUND:

In class on Wednesday, we started to look at how Harriet Beecher Stowe's sentimental form supported her novel's rhetorical purpose: to protest the institution of slavery in America.

At the time of its writing, most black Americans responded enthusiastically to *Uncle Tom's Cabin*. Frederick Douglass was a friend of Stowe's; she had consulted him on some sections of the book, a praised the book in his writings. Most black abolitionists saw it as a tremendous help to their cause Some, however, opposed the book, seeing Uncle Tom's character as being too submissive and crit Stowe for having her strongest black characters emigrate to Liberia. To this day, it is difficult to comprehend the complexities of racist feeling in America in the wake of *Uncle Tom's Cabin's*








