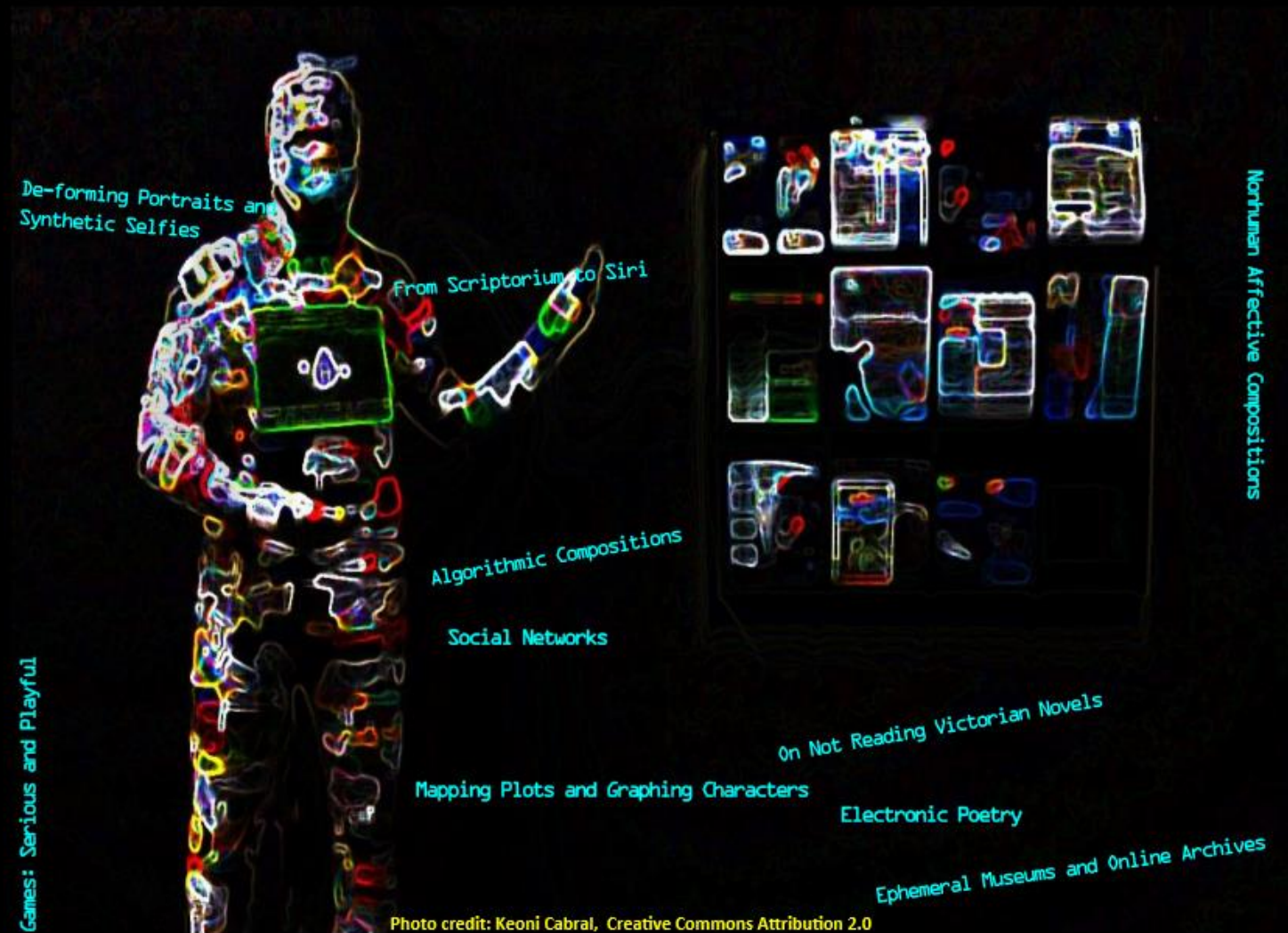

# Defining the Field

- “integrating digital technology into our scholarship will have to be pursued on as broad a scale as possible” Jerome McGann, 2005
- “Humanities computing is a model or mimicry, as a way of reasoning, as a set of ontological commitments: it determines what we can see, bringing some part of the world into sharp focus at the expense of blurring other parts. This blurring and bringing into focus is not an incidental side effect but the ‘essence’ of the work.” John Unsworth “What Digital Humanities is and What it is Not”

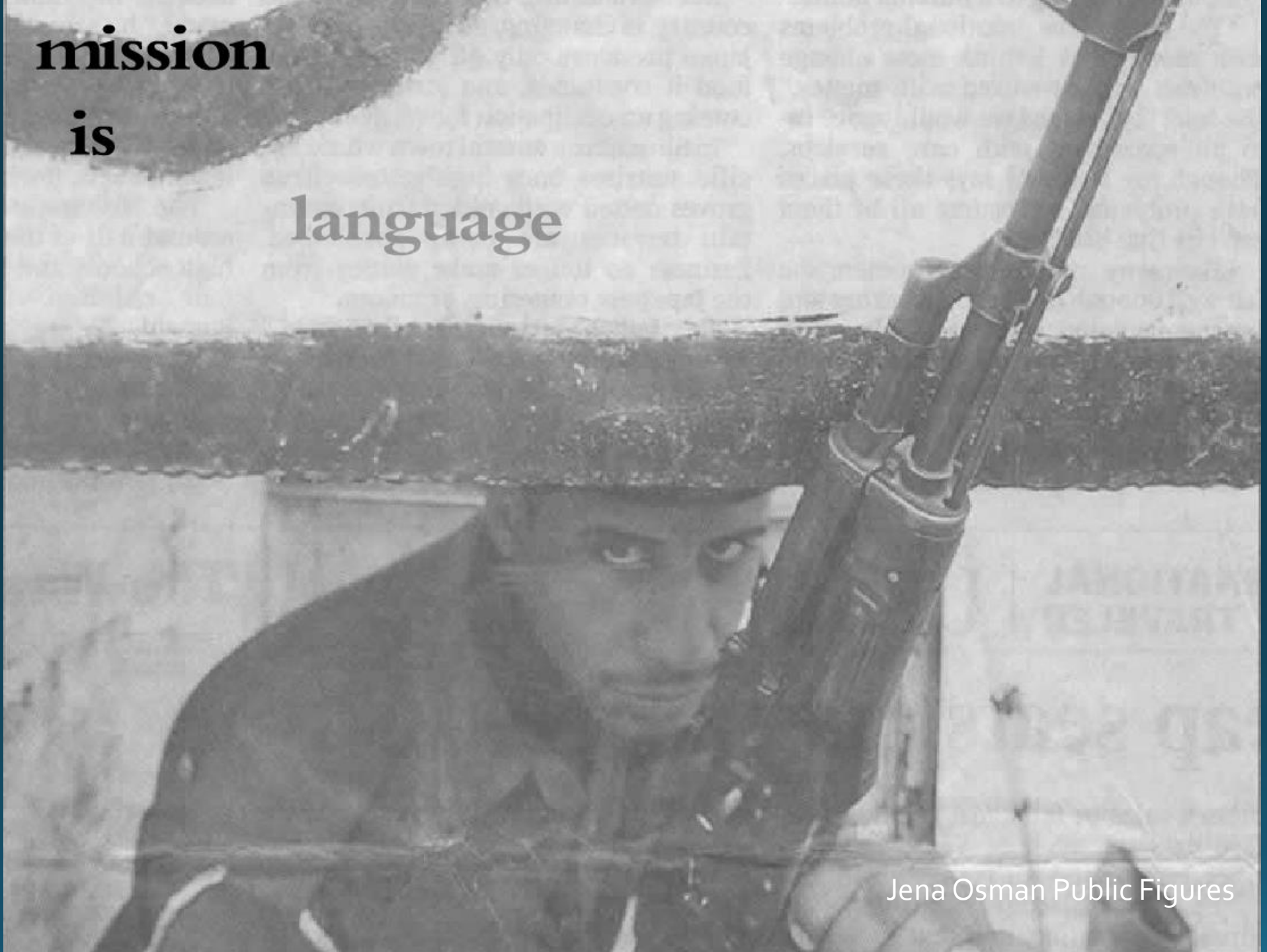
