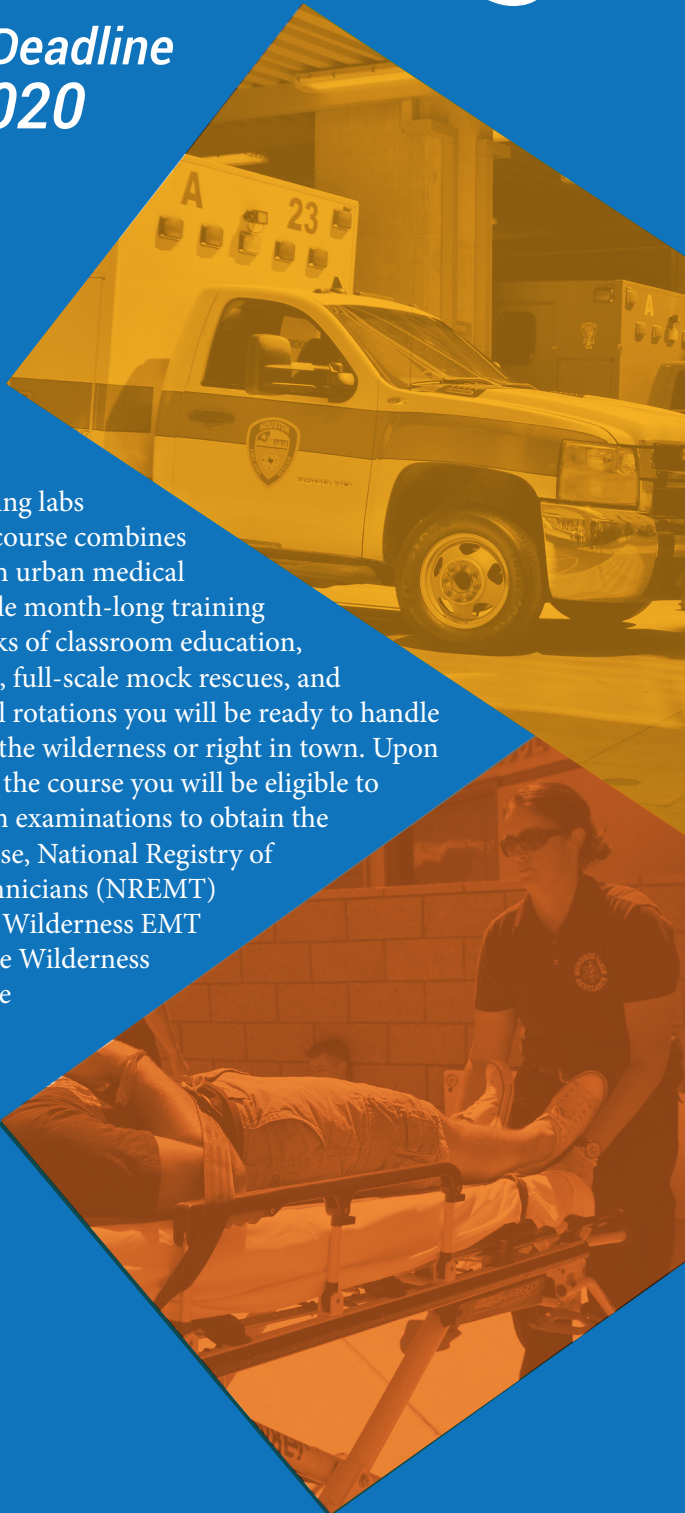


# Wilderness EMT Training

*Registration Deadline  
April 15, 2020*

This is a hybrid course and will include in-class, online, and open practicing labs portions. This intensive course combines wilderness medicine with urban medical care practices into a single month-long training program. After four weeks of classroom education, practical skills, scenarios, full-scale mock rescues, and patient contact in clinical rotations you will be ready to handle medical emergencies, in the wilderness or right in town. Upon successful completion of the course you will be eligible to take practical and written examinations to obtain the Oregon State EMT License, National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) EMT certification, and a Wilderness EMT certification following the Wilderness Medical Society's Practice Guidelines.
